Who should attend?

Aims

- ⚙️ Site hazards
- ⚙️ Entering and leaving customer sites
- ⚙️ Environmental issues
- ⚙️ Vehicle-specific hazards

Number of delegates: minimum 6, maximum of 20*

Duration and delivery: Either **1x7hr** course or **2x3.5hrs** courses within a 24hr period.
