



Safe Driving and Driver Behaviour for Company Car and Van Drivers

Who should attend?

Company Car Drivers, Company Van Drivers or Drivers who receive a car allowance

Any employee who is required to drive on company business either a **company car, company van or receives a car allowance**, who needs to be thinking about the factors that impact on a driver's attitude, and develop skills required to address these. - ⚙️ Understand what actions that may be needed to take in several emergency situations including breakdowns and accidents.

Content

- ⚙️ Corporate responsibilities and risk management
- ⚙️ Prestart checks and preventative maintenance
- ⚙️ Techniques to help delegates adopt a safer driving attitude.
- ⚙️ How to deal with situations that may arise when driving on the public highway
